Also, a mystery gift will be given to visitors who take part in our questionnaire survey & click “like” on our Facebook Page (Visit My Japan).

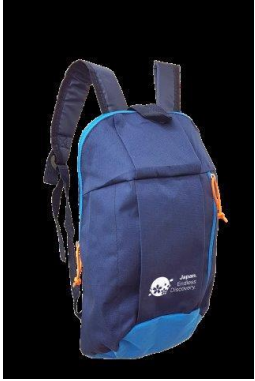
